January is Stalking Awareness Month

The Phoenix Center at Auraria VPE team will be hosting several tables across campus in the second half of January to educate the community on stalking: what it is, what to do if it happens to you and who can help. Research shows that 1 in 12 women and 1 in 45 men will experience stalking in their

lifetime yet it is often ignored or assumed harmless. Stalking includes any repeated behavior that causes someone to feel afraid and that could be anything from following to repeated facebooking or texting. On January 31st, in the Multicultural Lounge from 10am-2pm, the PCA will host a

"Know it, Name it, Stop it Stalking" tunnel - an interactive experience that folks can walk through to learn about the realities of stalking. Please try and stop by!
