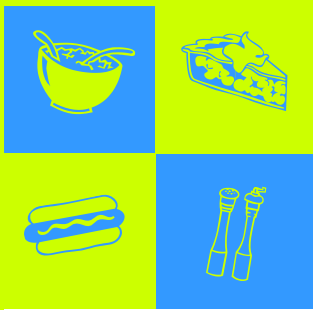

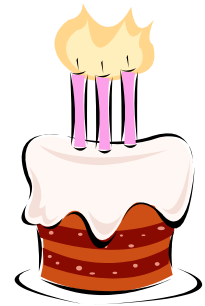
technology will also convene roundtable discussions designed to create a shared vision for a more cohesive hemisphere. For more information, visit www.biennialoftheamericas.org
