## Men Allied Against Violence

The Phoenix Center at Auraria, in conjunction with an Advisory Group of men from across campus, have collaborated to establish a new program for men- Men Allied Against Violence. Men Allied Against Violence aims to bring together a group of undergraduate men from all three Auraria institutions to talk openly and honestly about issues relating to masculinity, gender, and interpersonal violence. The group will be all male and facilitated by a male facilitator connected to the Auraria campus.

The group is scheduled to start in the Fall 2010 semester (Tuesday, October 5, 2010). Group sessions will be held on Tuesdays from 5:30-7:30pm. They will run for 12 sessions and span the Fall and Spring semesters.

The Men Allied Against Violence group will facilitate the creation of a peer led safe and confidential space for men to think critically about violence and discuss openly a variety of issues related to manhood (including but not limited to victimization, the meaning of masculinity, benefits of being male, sexuality, and healthy expressions of emotions). Once we begin to understand social messages around masculinity

and the way this affects our views of, and relationships with, others, we can begin to understand our power as it relates to interpersonal violence against others.
